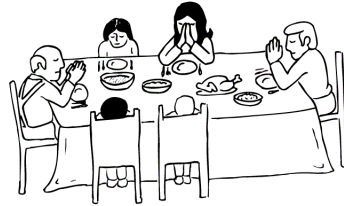
Upcoming Events
